I have seen all that was done to you!

“The angel of God said to me in the dream, ‘Jacob.’ I answered, ‘Here I am.’ And he said, ‘Look up and see that all the male goats mating with the flock are streaked, speckled or spotted, for I have seen all that Laban has been doing to you” [Genesis 31:11, 12].

The Lord is speaking these same words to us through this month’s Magazine. Just as the Lord revealed to Jacob that he had been seeing whatever Laban had been doing to him, he is revealing to you and I that he has been seeing whatever men have been doing to you and I. The Lord sees our shortcomings. But, He also sees the good and bad things that others do to us. After deceiving his own brother Esau of his birth right and fearing that he would kill him, Jacob fled to his uncle Laban’s house [his mother’s brother].

There he falls in love with his Uncle’s daughter Rachel. However, just as he had deceived his brother, his uncle deceives him in his marriage. Whatever harm we do to others we will get it back in return. As the Tamil Proverb that loosely translates to ‘What we do to others will come back to haunt us’ goes, Jacob was deceived. Instead of giving Rachel whom he loved, Laban deceptively gave him Leah, as his wife first and then gave Rachel later.

The days Jacob spent with Laban were cruel. Laban extracted hard labor from him. Laban prospered through the fruit of Jacob’s labor. Ten times he changed his wages. After he suffered innumerable difficulties, the angel called **“... ‘Jacob.’ I answered, ‘Here I am.’ And he said, ‘Look up and see that all the male goats mating with the flock are streaked, speckled or spotted, for I have seen all that Laban has been doing to you. I am the God of Bethel, where you anointed a pillar and where you made a vow to me. Now leave this land at once and go back to your native land”** (Genesis 31:11-13).

God spoke to Jacob in this manner because, although he had committed a mistake in the case of Esau, Jacob had remained faithful in worshipping the Lord. The Lord did not forget how he called unto him. The Lord didn't like Jacob being deceived by his uncle again and again. But he chastised Jacob in this manner to make him realize that he had sinned. But our Lord cannot bear to see us suffering for long. The difficulties and sufferings that we are undergoing may be punishment of the Lord. Without our knowledge we could have committed mistakes and brought harm on someone. Unless we realize it, God will not show mercy. You may be lamenting that I haven't done any harm to anyone, then why is this happening to me. If we fear the Lord and walk faithfully, the Lord is looking at all the harm that others are doing to us. He knows us. He answers our prayers. The Lord who spoke to Esau will definitely speak to our enemies!

Laban could have continued to persecute or even murdered Jacob. But God did not permit him to bring harm to him. He warned him to speak only good not bad with Jacob. The Lord protected Jacob. Jacob had cheated his father, then his brother and had earned the name 'Deceiver'. But he was faithful to his uncle. He repented of his sin, changed his attitude and did what the Lord asked him to do. He returned to his native land with fear of the Lord and petition. The Lord will never give permission to anyone to do us harm. Dear brothers and sisters, who are reading this Message, like Jacob we should also realize our mistakes, understand people, fear the Lord and do good to others. Then, as we read in Genesis 32:9,10 the Lord, who blessed Jacob with double fold blessings will also bless you!

The Path That I Trod

My dear Readers,

Loving Greetings to my Beloved Readers!

Each of us face challenges and difficulties of varying proportions in our lives every day. We cannot grade our levels of difficulty against each other. Each of our troubles are unique to us in some way. And it has been an especially thorny path to tread in recent times for most of us. But there is one way to change our rough road – Jesus who said I am the way, the truth and the life! [John 14:6].

Let me continue my journey from where I left off. I had written about the birth of my second child Sam in the previous edition. When the children were small my husband and I would take them along with us to different places, as we travelled for the Ministry. It is very difficult to travel with children. My husband Dr. John Solomon would dress up neat and prim. You would remember how he used to be dressed. Once he had finished dressing up even the children were not allowed to go near him. He was a man of discipline. So, I had to carry them. But, my children were very well-behaved and conducted themselves in a godly manner right from their young age, when we used to take them to Church and Ministry.

Both of us would be on the stage and we would leave the children with some responsible person. They used to be very quiet and disciplined. When we went to minister in Churches, they would sit quietly on the floor, resting their head on their hands and they would listen to the Message very carefully without even blinking their eyes. Parents used to appreciate our children and ask their children to emulate their conduct. I believe that the reason for this is that both my husband and I were very strict with them in matters pertaining to God.

This is an incident that I can never forget in my life. My husband was called to preach in a very big Meeting and I was to sing before the Sermon. In those days, all the Posters, Hand-bills and Advertisements that were published about our Ministry always used to read as: “Songs by Sis. Shanthi Solomon and Message by Dr. John Solomon”. I would sing before my husband delivered the Message. And also, after the Sermon, I would sing the song of invitation to the Altar. Many used to respond to the invite and have written to us about the time, when they gave their lives to Christ. I have preserved those letters of testimony in my Office. In this Meeting, they announced in the loud speaker that I would sing a song before my husband’s Sermon. I was sitting at the rear end of the stage with my children. When I heard my name being announced, I left them with a brother and ran to the stage. I sang a Hindi Song and went back to the place where my children were. But, I was shocked to find my daughter Sheba was missing. I panicked and asked the brother what had happened. With much angst he replied that he had been so enthralled in listening to my singing and he hadn’t noticed her slipping off. Just then, I heard a small voice in the mike from the stage. Sheba was struggling to reach the mike and with a loud voice she sang the entire Hindi Song that I had just sung. She was only 3 years old and everyone was spell-bound.

The brother who was supposed to look after her started calling her ‘Shebaki Queen’ and ‘Singapore Queen’ for the rest of the time we were there. I am thankful to God for enabling us to nurture our children with the fear of the Lord right from their young age. My husband and I have ministered in many Churches in the South of Tamil Nadu. We have ministered extensively in Tirunelveli, Nagercoil and Kannyakumari. I can never forget those Meetings, their food and the hospitality that was from the heart. Even in North India, we have visited many Churches and shared God’s Word in Conventions. In every place that we went, the love and affection that was showered on us by the people is immeasurable. I have learnt many Hindi Songs during our trips to minister in North India.
